### **B.** Support Staff Representative:

Don Watt made a motion to approve the request to add a non-voting member from the Support Staff Association to Faculty Senate. The request was made by the representative, Clarisa Liston, on behalf of the Support Staff Association at the January 21, 2020. Mathew Brust seconded the motion. Nine members voted in favor of the motion with one member voting against the motion. Motion carried by majority.

# C. Faculty Senate Constitution and By-laws:

Senators reviewed the draft of the Faculty Senate Constitution with changes recommended by Dr. Randy Rhine and former VPAA, Dr. Charles Snare, in December. The changes reflect an effort by the Administration and Faculty Senate task force examining the Constitution to better align the policies with the changes to the board policies made by the Nebraska State College System. After some discussion regarding the recommended changes, Senators were asked to review the Constitution once again seeking input from faculty. All recommendations for changes should be forwarded to Kathleen Woods, Faculty Senate task force member, who will update revisions and upload to Sharepoint for review at the next Faculty Senate meeting.

1. The Faculty Senate task force made up of Deane Tucker, Kathleen Woods and Mathew Brust will continue their review of the Faculty Senate Constitution and By-laws and bring their proposal for revisions back to Faculty Senate for review.
