
Recollections

"I loved Edna Work, the dean of women, so I could not understand why I was called into her office one day. It didn't take me long to learn the reason. The Chadron State football team had played at the University of Wyoming the previous weekend. My young friend, "Betty," and I wanted to go. We found Berne Rochek getting ready to go...and we asked if we could ride along...All went well. We got a room in the hotel where the team was staying, went to the game and came home. Verne had been waiting in the lobby, so we rode off without paying the bill, leaving the college to pay for it. I took full responsibility...since I was older. I paid the bill, apologized to Miss Work, who never mentioned it again. I don't think I could have enjoyed college anywhere else as much as I did at CSC."
