
An Earned Retirement

Free airfare has been extended to January 31, 2023 join the over 30 Alumni who have already signed up!



Recollections are excerpts of stories submitted to the College for the 75th Anniversary book written by Con Marshall. If you are interested in reading the full story please contact the Alumni office. The following is an excerpt entitled "No One Questioned His Calls" by Dr. Lawrence Lindahl.

"Dr. Fred B. Harrington, head of psychology and education at Chadron State...in 1930, was a mystery to the

students. To me, he was a wonderful friend and we had many good times with him and his wife, Ruby. He liked to play pinochle and chess...He also sang in the city choir organized and directed by Dr. T.R. Scholz, a Chadron dentist.

"Harrington enjoyed baseball and gave one of the most interesting talks on the sport at a college assembly...He did not play the sport himself...but he liked to umpire. During the '30s, softball became popular in Chadron...Harrington umpired most of the games. When he called 'S-T-R-I-K-E three' you knew you were out and no one ever questioned his calls."
