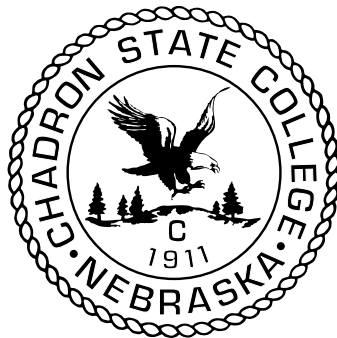
Academic Regalia

The history of academic dress goes back to the early days of the oldest universities. In England, in the second half of the 14th Century, statutes of certain colleges prohibited “excess in apparel” and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. Originally gowns may have been worn for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars.

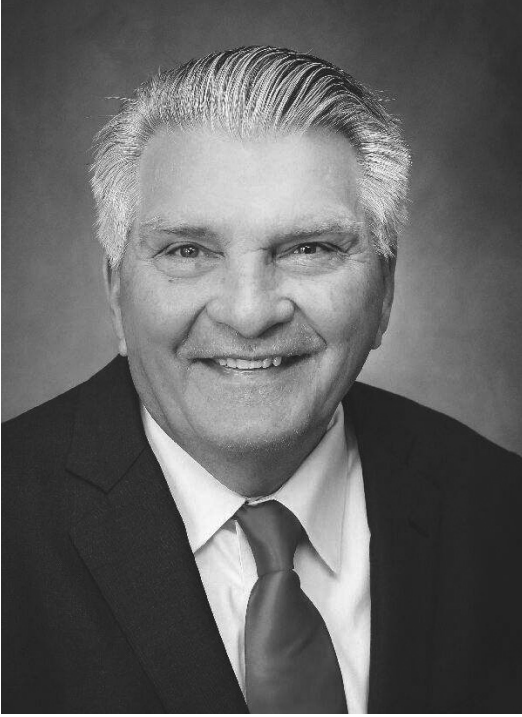
The gown is usually of black material. Bachelors’ gowns have long pointed sleeves; Masters’ gowns have full-length square sleeves, crescent-shaped at the bottom; and the Doctors’ gowns have full, round, open sleeves. The Doctors’ gown is closed and faced with panels of velvet down the front. Three velvet bars decorate each sleeve.

The cap, generally the square mortar-board, but sometimes for Doctors, a round, soft, flat velvet hat (a style borrowed from foreign universities), bears a tassel which may be black for all ranks and degrees, or may be of gold thread for Doctors and the color of the degree for Bachelors and Masters. Only the Doctors’ cap may be of velvet.

The hood is the principal indicator of the nature and source of the degree. Bachelors’ hoods are three feet long with two-inch wide velvet side-panels; Masters’, three-and-one-half with three-inch panels, and Doctors’, four feet with five-inch panels. The silk lining bears the colors of the institution that conferred the degree and the color of the velvet panels indicates the field of study. Hoods may be worn only after the degree has been granted.



Commencement Speaker



The speaker for today's commencement is former Nebraska State Senator John Stinner Sr. He was elected to the Nebraska Legislature, representing District 48, in 2014 and re-elected 2018, before his term expired in 2022.

A native of Pennsylvania, Stinner came to Nebraska on a full athletic scholarship and was a member of the University of Nebraska national championship football team in 1970-71. He earned a bachelor's degree in business administration in 1973 and master's in economics from UNL in 1976.

Stinner and his wife, Rita, have been married since 1972 and have two children and four grandchildren. The couple resides in Gering. He is a retired CPA and the former CEO and board chair of Valley Bank of Trust. He also served on the board of directors of Western States Bank.

Stinner's civic service has included work with the following organizations: the Oregon Trail Community Foundation, the Scottsbluff/Gering Rotary Club, the Sons of the American Legion, the Knights of Columbus, the Gering Downtown Revitalization Committee, Elks Club, the WNCC Cougar Booster Club, and Christ the King parish.

Stinner is a former board member and trustee with Hospital Authority No. 1 of Scotts Bluff County and former chair of the Nebraska Bankers Association. He also served on numerous boards including the Western Nebraska Community College Foundation, the Terry Carpenter Center, the

Nebraska Journalism Trust, and the WyoBraska Museum. He served as president of the YMCA of Scottsbluff board, the Gering School Board, and Twin Cities Development.

His honors include the 2024 State Chamber of Commerce Business Hall of Fame, 2023 Behavioral Health Educational Center of Nebraska Distinguished Service Award, 2023 Nebraskaland Foundation NEBRASKAlander Award, the Nebraska Arts Council Thomas C. Woods III Partner in the Arts Award, State Friend of Psychology from the Nebraska Psychological Association, and Nebraska Society of CPA Legislator of the Year in 2023.

"Chadron State is such a great asset to the Panhandle and the state of Nebraska from an economic and post-secondary perspective. It's a great honor to be asked to be a part of the commencement ceremony," Stinner said.
