Vice President Konery Klueber v. Kent Hall Senator, Michael Pacheco

Opinion of the Court:

- Per Curiam

On March 12, 2019, Konery Kluber, Vice President of Student Senate, filed a petition with the Court, alleging that Kent Hall Senator Michael Pacecho missed meetings on November 19, 2018; November 26, 2018; January 7, 2019; January 14, 2019; and March 11, 2019, constituting a regular absence and was therefore, unexcused, and violates the Student Senate bylaw regarding "ATTENDANCE."

After Vice President Klueber filed the petition, Senator Pacheco was served the petition and did not file a response within the designated two academic days. This Court therefore issues a summary judgement in favor of the petitioner, finding that there was a violation of the Senate bylaw regarding "ATTENDANCE" and, hereby ORDERS Senator Pacheco to attend all regular and special meetings of Senate and to strictly follow all attendance guidelines as spelled out in the Student Senate Bylaws.
