Vice President Sayaloune. v. Trajan Garcia, Brooks Hall Senator

Opinion of the Court:

- Per Curiam

On October 26, 2017, Jonathan Sayaloune, Vice President of Student Senate, filed a petition with the Court, alleging Brooks Hall Senator, Trajan Garcia was absent to the Student Senate meetings without notice or cause on October 9 and October 23, 2017.

After Vice President Sayaloune filed the petition, Senator Garcia was served the petition and did not file a response within the designated two academic days. This Court therefore issues a summary judgement in favor of the petitioner, finding that there was a violation of the Senate bylaw regarding "ATTENDANCE" and, hereby ORDERS Senator Garcia to attend all regular and special meetings of Senate and to strictly follow all attendance guidelines as spelled out in the Student Senate Bylaws.
