Vice President Brunswick. v. Andrews Hall Senator, Guerrero

Opinion of the Court:

- Per Curiam

On February 9, 2018, Dawson Brunswick, Vice President of Student Senate, filed a petition with the Court, alleging Andrews Hall Senator, Leah Guerrero was absent to the Student Senate meetings without notice or cause February 5, 2018.

After Vice President Brunswick filed the petition, Senator Guerrero was served the petition. This act, if proved, would require the Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus ordering Senator Guerrero to comply with the Senate bylaw regarding attendance. Where Senator Guerrero's term has ended, the Court does not consider this argument. By Senator Guerrero presenting President Carly Slaght with a letter of resignation February 11, 2018, the Court cannot grant the relief sought by Vice President Brunswick, even if the allegation were proven. Therefore, this Court dismisses the Petition for Review PR 17-04 without a hearing to prove the facts.
