Vice President Sayaloune. v. Maikayla Weiss, B.E.A.M.S.S. Senator

Opinion of the Court:

On September 25, 2017, Jonathan Sayaloune, Vice President of Student Senate, filed a petition with the Court, alleging that B.E.A.M.S.S. Senator Maikayla Weiss was tardy to the Student Senate meetings on August 28, 2017 and September 18, 2017 thus equaling one unexcused absence to Student Senate.

After Vice President Sayaloune filed the petition, Senator Weiss was served the petition and did not file a response within the designated two academic days. This Court therefore issues a summary judgement in favor of the petitioner, finding that there was a violation of the Senate bylaw regarding "ATTENDANCE" and, hereby ORDERS Senator Weiss to attend all regular and special meetings of Senate and to strictly follow all attendance guidelines as spelled out in the Student Senate Bylaws.
