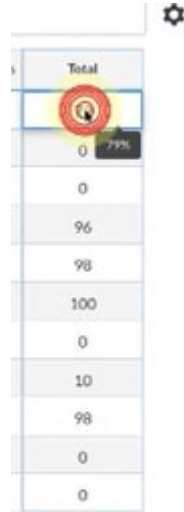


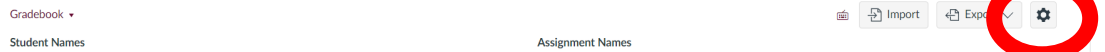
Adjusting Final Course Grades in Canvas Gradebook

Course instructors can adjust students' final course grades manually. For situations where an instructor may want to adjust a student's final grade (perhaps on the bubble for going up a letter grade and the student did extra work), there is a method for bumping up grades.

- a. The instructor cannot directly edit the grade in the Total column of the Gradebook.

- b. The Gradebook has a feature to override the final grade. Click on the Settings gear icon on the upper right-hand side of the Gradebook.

- c. In the pop-up screen there should be a third tab called **Advanced**, click on the tab.
