

## Turnitin Plagiarism Review Set Up

Turnitin is an originality checking and plagiarism prevention software used at Chadron State College. An instructor can use this service to have student work submitted to which will compare student work to a large database of digital content.

The software is integrated into the Canvas Learning Management System (LMS) for ease of access and use. Within a course, while creating or editing an Assignment, select '**Online**' as the Submission Type. Under Online Entry Options check the '**File Uploads**' box. Below there is a section labeled Plagiarism Review, select '**Turnitin Plagiarism Review**'.

- Exclude small sources
- Enable grammar checking using ETS® e-rater® technology

If ETS e-rater Technology is also selected, the user will have to determine what handbook is used and what categories the service will review.
